

## **COMMONS ACT 2006 — SECTION 15(1)**

### **Notice of an application for the registration of land as a Town or Village Green**

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others whom it may concern.

Application has been made to the Dorset County Council County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester by Mr Philip Arthur Atlay, Chairman 'Keep Wimborne Town Green' of 25 King Street, Wimborne Minster, Dorset under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007. The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town and village greens of the land described in the Schedule below which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 23 September 2009 by virtue of the ability of members of the public to enter Hanhams's Ground at will for over 20 years and use of Hanham's Ground as a cricket ground and by a number of groups for recreation and games.

The application, which includes a plan of the land proposed for registration may be inspected at Main Reception, County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester Dorset during normal office hours.

Copies of the documents may also be inspected at the following local authority offices: East Dorset District Council, Council Offices, Furzehill, Wimborne, Dorset, BH21 4HN; and Wimborne Town Council, The Town Hall, 37 West Borough, Wimborne Minster, Dorset BH21 1LT.

If the registration authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land. Any person wishing to object to the registration of the land as a town or village green should send a statement of the facts on which the objection is based to Legal Services, Dorset County Council, County Hall, Colliton Park Dorchester DT1 1XJ (Ref: SLM/E103262) on or before 19 March 2010. Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties.

#### **Schedule**

Description of the land claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green  
Land as shown on the plans accompanying the application and described as Hanham's Ground, Rowlands Hill, Wimborne Minster in the East Dorset District, otherwise known as Wimborne Minster Cricket Ground. The area is bounded by the River Allen to the west, Crown Mead and Park Lane to the south, Rowlands Hill to the east and Streets Meadow Residential Care Home and the Hanham Centre to the north.
